



Wisconsin QSO Party 2022 Results



Summary

2022 saw a decrease in log entries with 450 logs submitted vs. 542 logs last year. Out-of-state participation came in at 53 entries less and in-state at 39 entries less. Several factors may have contributed, Covid fatigue, the threat of a CME headed towards earth and terrestrial weather. Weather across the state differed considerably. While much of the state enjoyed good winter conditions, the northwest was impacted making mobile operations difficult and shortened operations for those operating at a secondary QTH in northwest Wisconsin. Typically this part of the state is covered by mobiles from our Minnesota comrades.

Two standing records were broken in 2022, Single Op Fixed (SOF) and Single-Op Rookie (SOR). Chad Kurszewski, WE9V, broke his old SOF record score of 207,654 points set in 2021 with 214,528 points logged this year. Jim Klas, KF9VV, broke the old SOR record score of 52,668 points set in 2016 by logging 53,985 points in 2022. Nice job!

WIQP 2022

We received 448 logs, down 17% over 2021 and roughly even with 2020. Wisconsin stations submitted 136 logs this year, down 23%. Non-Wisconsin stations submitted 312 logs this year, down 15%.

The role the state QSO Party challenge plays in out-of-state participation will be an item for further analysis at the end of the year. It is not clear if the drop in non-Wisconsin entries is due to a waning interest in the state QSO Party challenge or other factors. The launch of the challenge was concurrent with the beginning of the Covid quarantine so perhaps there is a strong correlation.

County Activation

Logs reported QSOs sent from 61 of 72 counties. The missing counties were Barron, Burnett, Green, Iron, Marinette, Oconto, Oneida, Polk, Richland, Vilas, and Washburn. 71 counties have reports of QSOs received. Only Vilas County has no reported QSOs.

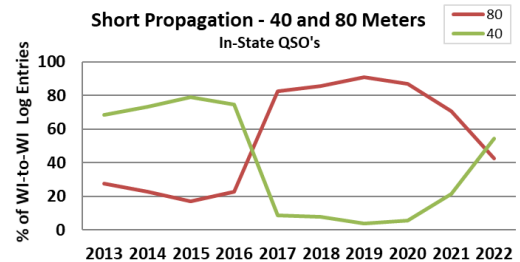
What an opportunity for mobiles and rovers! These counties are the perfect QTH for starting a pileup. We need mobiles and rovers to help stimulate the low activity counties. Any fixed stations that have not jumped in would have a fun afternoon as well.

In 2022, 18 counties were activated only by mobiles, down a bit from 22 last year. Overall, mobile QSOs were reported in 47 counties, however mobile operation saw a decrease in the 2022 party. This is a concern since mobiles really characterize state QSO parties. We encourage anyone inclined to operate mobile to do so—we need you! Hopefully this year was an anomaly influenced by weather, gas prices, or other factors, and we will see the seasoned as well as new mobile ops return to the party. Thanks to everyone who made the extra effort to get on the road for our party!

As in recent years, WIQP county activation data will be put on the website after the results are published.

Activity by Band

We continue to track the number of short propagation QSOs on 80 and 40 meters, analyzing in-state QSO totals. As we approach the solar maximum, the results are as expected—40 meters is making a return while fewer in-state QSOs are being made on 80 meters. In fact, 40 meters was the band to be on this year with the majority of short propagation QSOs completed.

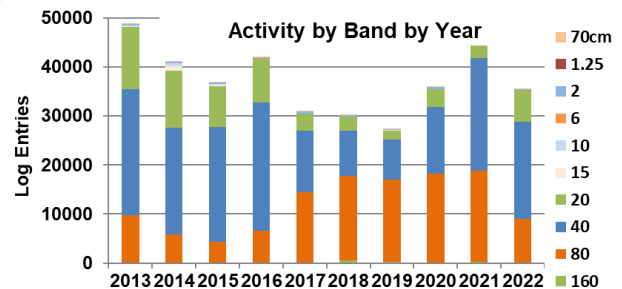
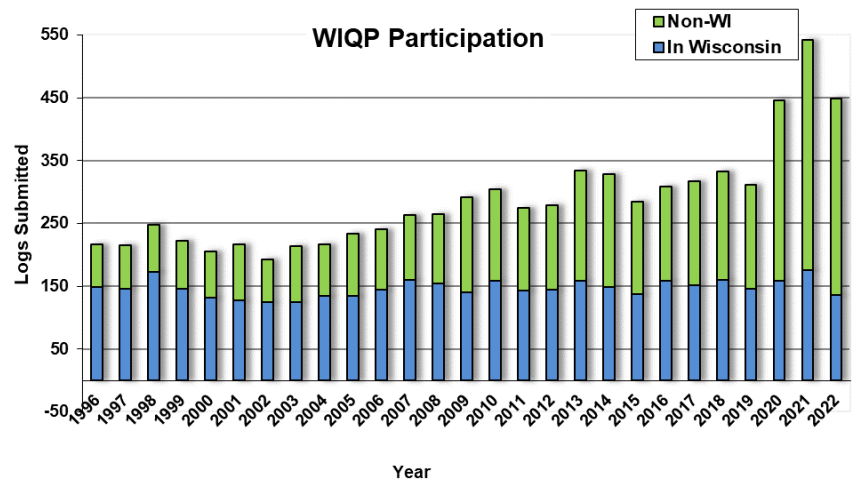


Category Results

Single Op Rookie (SOR)

Thirteen Rookie logs were received from Wisconsin stations this year compared to seventeen last year. Eighteen Rookie logs were received from outside the state.

This year's top Rookie is Jim Klas, KF9VV, of Prairie du Sac in Sauk County, with 53,985 points on 295 CW Q's. The second place Rookie is Kevin Duffy (WQ9F), operating W9W. Kevin is from Chicago, but was operating in the WIQP and POTA from Bong Recreational Area in Kenosha County. He made 424 phone Q's.



Rookie entries held steady at 31 this year vs. 32 last year. Thanks to all the Rookies for entering WIQP! We hope you had fun and will be back next year.

The Rookie category, as the name implies, is to encourage newcomers to get involved and join the fun. Entrants do not need to be new hams--just new to WIQP. The Rookie category is available to new entrants for two consecutive years--see rules for details. All entrants in this category receive a certificate.

Single Op Fixed (SOF)

Chad Kurszewski, WE9V, in Kenosha County once again takes the top spot with 214,528 points on 866 total Q's. Runner-up is Justin Glasener, K9MU, who logged an impressive 701 Q's, for a score of 156,703.5. Justin operated from Altoona in Eau Claire County.

Congratulations Chad and Justin, and thanks to all 107 SOF entries from Wisconsin stations.

Multi-Op Fixed (MOF)

First place in this category is awarded to Bruce Richardson, W9FZ, and Janice Hoettels, KA9VVQ. They scored 85,446 points with a total of 469 QSO's operating from Vernon County near Hillsboro. Bruce and Janice are regulars in the MOF category. Congratulations on taking first place this year!

Second place goes to Kent Scheuerell, K9ZMU, and Scott Scheuerell, N9HDE. They were not far behind Bruce and Janice with 70,875 points with a total of 396 Q's operating from Grant County.

Congratulations to both of the above groups and thanks to all seven MOF entries for your efforts!

Multi-Multi Fixed (MMF)

There were five entries in this group, up from three last year. Top honors go to the Mississippi Valley Amateur Radio Association, turning in a score of 121,883.5 points on 675 Q's. Making up their team was Scott Neader, KA9FOX, Mitchel Schultz, WB0GKH, Eric Papenfuss, WX9EP, Craig Goldbeck, N9ETD, William Kleinschmidt, N9FDE, Robert Mullin, KG7SDC, and Steven Miller, KC1MDK.

Second in this category is the team of Mark Endorf, WA0MHJ, and John Baumgarten, N0IJ. They scored 63,180 points on 378 Q's from Douglas County. Mark and John made a valiant effort in dealing with severe winter weather in NW Wisconsin--an impressive second place with operation limited to 3.5 hours due to heavy snow! Mark and John are no strangers to the WIQP, migrating from Minnesota in past years to cover NW Wisconsin in individual mobile operations.

Thanks to all five teams operating in the MMF category!

Single-Op Mobile (SOM)

There were four Single-Op mobiles this year and one MMM. The MOM category did not have any entries.

Mark Seyffer, KB9S, lead the SOMs with a score of 169,350 points. Mark covered 16 counties racking up a total of 830 CW Q's with 65 mults. Mark's route focused on a segment of Wisconsin's central counties. Starting in his home county of EAU, traveling west to DUN then south through PEP and BUF, navigating east to TRE, JAC, and MON before turning north to JUN. Next, heading NE through WOO, POR, MAR, SHA and then turning back west through LAN, LIN, TAY, and concluding his route in CLA.

Unfortunately, the Minnesota mobiles were absent this year. We hope to see them back since they do a great job of covering some of the lower activity counties in Western Wisconsin. We welcome and appreciate your participation. Thank you!

Multi-Op Mobile (MOM)

No MOM entries were submitted this year.

Multi-Multi Mobile (MMM)

The Scott Dawley, N9SD, and Dave Hanus team was the sole entry in the MMM category this year. By default, he has the highest score in the category, but also the second highest score in the mobile categories overall.

Scott and Dave covered 17 counties. They started in DOO and looped north/south through KEW, MAN, BRO, CAL, OUT, WIN, WAP, and WSR, then headed west to POR. From there they traveled an east and south route covering WOO, JUN, ADA, MRQ, GRL, COL, and DOD. They experimented with keeping a 2 meter radio operational as well, but it yielded only a handful of Q's. This year was unusually light on VHF Q's, so perhaps VHF will fare better next year.

Top Non-Wisconsin Single-Op

This year's out-of-state honors and the Top Non-WI plaque go to David Pritchard, W9QL, in Illinois. David scored 20,312.5 points on 223 Q's. Cedrick Johnson, WT2P, also in Illinois, is this year's runner-up with 16,215 points on 184 QSO's.

The number of logs from outside Wisconsin was down somewhat – 312 compared to 367 in 2021. Congratulations to all the participating non-Wisconsin hams. We enjoy hosting and invite you back next year!

Top QRP Station

Joel Kluender, W9JFK, secured the top position in the QRP ranks for a third consecutive year. Operating from Grant County, he earned 53,010 points on 235 QSO's, almost exclusively on CW. Second place goes to Mark Swartwout, NX1K, from Massachusetts. Mark scored 5,096 points on 46 Q's.

Fifteen QRP stations submitted logs compared to eleven last year. Ten are from out of state.

Top VHF Station

The VHF plaque has a 500 point minimum which no one attained this year. Per the WIQP rules, the plaque is not awarded. Thirty-one stations reported 100 VHF/UHF QSO's in 2022, twenty-three fewer ops than last year and 554 fewer VHF Q's.

Club Competition

The Ozaukee Radio Club takes top honors in the club competition this year with an aggregate score of 309,640 points contributed by 8 members. Top scorers were Gary Sutcliffe, W9XT, Vic Shier, WT9Q, and Fred Schwierske, W9KEY, all operating SOF stations.

The second place club is the Chippewa Valley VHF Contesters with 268,110 points contributed by 3 members. Contributors were Justin Glasener, K9MU, Scott Jasper, NE9U, and Al Schlaugat, N9ISN, all SOF stations.

W9FK Bonus

The West Allis club call, W9FK, was activated again by Phil Gural, W9NAW, from his home station in Waukesha County. 217 phone QSO's were made for 21,483 points. Note that the W9FK activity is listed under "WARAC Bonus Station--W9FK" in the club listing and is not included in the West Allis Club aggregate score. Thanks to Phil for being W9FK for a day.

Log Submissions

Log submissions were almost completely electronic this year, either through direct email or the use of the WA7BNM Cabrillo Web Form. With the growth of the Wisconsin QSO Party, digital management and processing is needed to deliver timely results. Each log is rescored since the claimed score calculated in the various logging programs may not account for every scoring nuance. This allows us to achieve very good quality and consistency. If you don't usually send in your log, please consider doing so. We want your logs!
