



Wisconsin QSO Party 2023 Results



Summary

What fantastic solar weather conditions we had for the 2023 Wisconsin QSO party! 501 logs were received compared to 450 logs last year. An all-time record was set for in-state logs received, 205 logs submitted from in-state participants. Submissions from outside Wisconsin totaled 296, a decline from the record high of 367 in 2021. Current records date back to 1996. Terrestrial weather was a mix of fair/good driving to challenging winter driving conditions. Extra thank-you's go out to mobiles operating north of a line from La Crosse to Sheboygan, facing the most difficult driving circumstances.

Plaque Winners

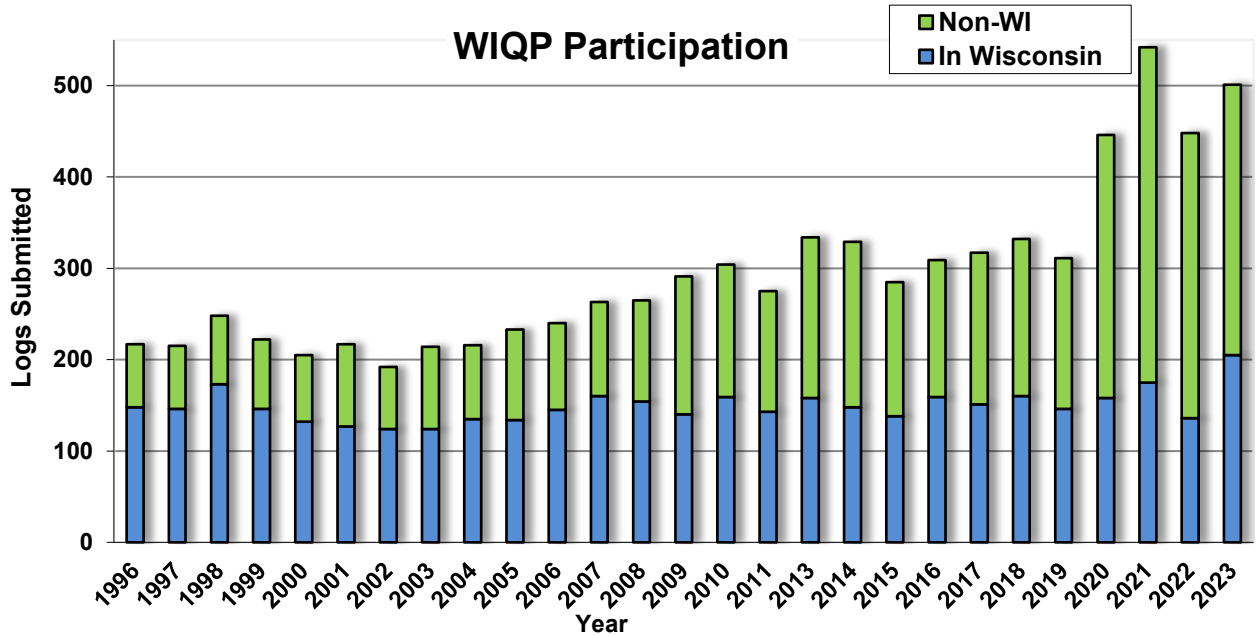

One standing record was broken, Single Op Rookie (SOR). Kevin Duffy, WQ9F, broke the old SOR record score of 53,985 set in 2022 by logging 72,824 points. Nice job and congratulations to all the winners!

WIQP 2023

501 logs were received, up 11% over 2022. Wisconsin stations submitted 205 logs, up a hefty 51%. Non-Wisconsin stations submitted 296 logs, down 5%.



County Activation

Logs received reported QSOs sent from 61 of Wisconsin's 72 counties. No logs were received from stations operating in Bayfield, Clark, Florence, Forest, Iron, Lafayette, Langlade, Lincoln, Marinette, Oneida, and Rusk counties. 68 counties have reports of QSOs received. Bayfield, Iron, Langlade, and Rusk seem to be absent of any reported QSOs. Driving conditions likely had an impact on these counties being activated despite very good solar conditions. An interesting observation was the activation of all 50 states this year.

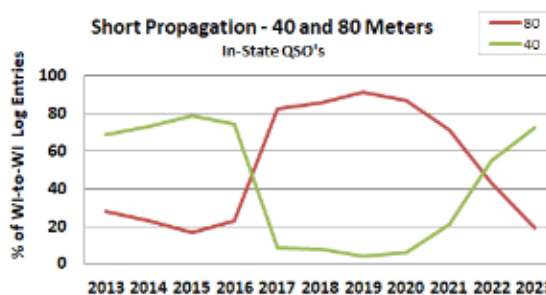
Opportunities exist for ops to get on the air from these low activity counties and cause some pile-ups! If you know of any hams in these counties, let them know how much fun they could be having on the second Sunday in March! If you're inclined to operate mobile, consider including these counties in your route planning.

Ten counties were activated only by mobiles. This is down by eight counties over 2022. In contrast, 13 mobiles reported 4,921 QSOs in 50 counties vs. 5 mobiles reporting 2820 QSOs in 47 counties in 2022. The increase in mobile activity is good news for the Wisconsin QSO party. Six mobiles logged VHF activity, four were exclusively VHF.

A huge thanks to all the mobiles for getting on the road this year. You take on additional planning and expenses and it is much appreciated! This year's results will be incorporated into the WIQP county activation data published on the website as it has been in previous years.

Activity by Band

Since 2013, the short propagation on 40 and 80 meters has been analyzed. As the 11th year approaches, it is clear that the solar cycle is a major factor. 40 meters played a significant role this year, staying open until the end of the contest at 0100z. 20 meters was another record setter this year, performing better than any year since records have been kept. Experts predict that solar maximum is still 2 years away. This is fantastic news; the bands should be in great shape for quite a while.

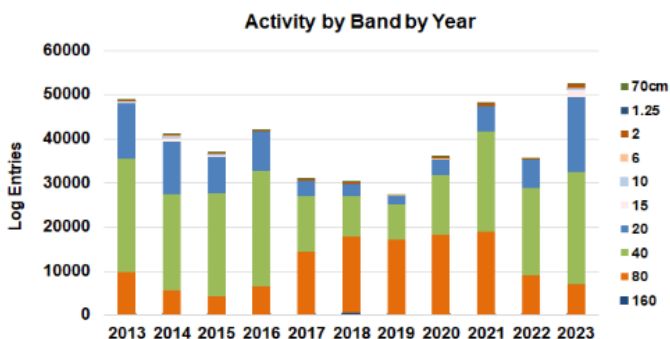


Category Results

Single Op Rookie (SOR)

Twenty-one Rookie logs were received from Wisconsin stations this year compared to thirteen last year. Nine Rookie logs were received from outside the state giving us a total of thirty Rookies.

This year's top Rookie is Kevin Duffy, WQ9F. Kevin is from Chicago, but was operating in the WIQP from Walworth County. He made an impressive 588 phone QSOs for a score of 72,824. Kevin also set a new record for Top Op Rookie.



Single Op Fixed (SOF)

Justin Glasener, K9MU, from Eau Claire County took the top honors in the SOF category this year. He logged 175,240 points on 765 total Q's. In second place was Scott Jasper, NE9U, operating from Dunn County at 161,093 points on 683 Q's. Both scores contributed to the aggregate score for the Chippewa Valley VHF Contesters Club. Congratulations to Justin and Scott as well as all 153 Wisconsin station entering in the SOF category.

Multi-Op Fixed (MOF)

The MOF category had twelve entries this year with first place being awarded to Yellow Thunder Amateur Radio Club, W9ET, operated by Joe and Linda Mayenschein, WB9SBD and KA9CHM, from Sauk County. They turned in 104,964.5 points on 492 Q's.

In second place was Bruce Richardson and Janice Hoettels, W9FZ and KA9VVQ, scoring 103,850 points on 554 Q's. As in past years, they operated from Vernon County.

Congratulations to both of you and all twelve MOF category groups.

Multi-Multi Fixed (MMF)

2023 yielded two groups competing in the MMF category. The top spot in this category goes to the Mississippi Valley Amateur Radio Association team, W9MVA, with an impressive 248,454 points on 1,045 Q's. Their team members include Scott Neader, KA9FOX, Mitchel Schultz, WB0GKH, Tom Speropulos, WA9TS, Craig Goldbeck, N9ETD, Steven Miller N9SJM, and Joshua Larson, KD9QKX.

Second place in the category was Bob Schmidt's, N9GMT, FM38 Repeater Group team. They scored 85,615 points on 546 Q's. The FM38 Repeater Group included Bob Schmidt, N9GMT, Emil Devcic, N9FBF, Chris Rozman, KD9JAI, Steve Dryja, NO9B, and DeWayne Griffith, N9DEG.

Single-Op Mobile (SOM)

Thirteen mobiles participated in the Wisconsin QSO party this year, nine SOM, two MOM, and two MMM. The first place SOM was Scott Dawley, N9SD, with a commanding 186,900 points on 825 Q's. Following Scott was Mark Seyffer, KB9S, with 160,122 points on 746 Q's. Also noteworthy were four mobiles with a significant amount of VHF activity operating in the Fox Valley.

Special thanks to the Minnesota mobiles and those operating in the northern half of Wisconsin for battling the difficult driving conditions.

Multi-Op Mobile (MOM)

The WO9B team turned in an impressive score of 159,987 points on 741 Q's, securing the MOM first place spot. The crew included Mike Johnson, WO9B, Michael Falk, AA9RK, and Frank Humpal, KA9FZR.

Second place was W9UP, the Riverland Amateur Radio Club group consisting of Drew Neve, AB9NE, Daniel Abts, AB9TS, and Ricky Kolter, KD9GVS. They logged 307 Q's resulting in a score of 40,203 points.

Multi-Multi Mobile (MMM)

Special event call K9M was used by Dave White, KZ9V and Michael Martens, KB9VBR in their MMM operation from Northwest Wisconsin. They completed 612 Q's for 106,264 points, taking first place.

Second place was garnered by the Northeast Wisconsin Amateur Radio Club, K9TIT. The K9TIT team included Tim Hale, KC9FSH, Andrew Skjoldager, KC9IZF, and Nathaniel Welch, AB9TE. They made 437 Q's for a score of 57,440 points.

Thanks go out to all those going mobile! The personal expenses incurred and the extra effort needed to make it happen is much appreciated. Those of us operating fixed stations enjoy chasing you into that next county and working you over and over again!

Top Non-Wisconsin Single-Op

This year's out-of-state leader was David Pritchard, W9QL, hailing from Illinois. With 287 Q's and 30,644 points, David secured the top position. In second place was another Illinois operator, Pete Walter, K9PW. Pete came in with a score of 27,049 on 224 Q's. The logs from outside Wisconsin continues on a slight decline with 296 logs vs. 312 last year, despite fifty states and eleven provinces showing activity. We enjoy hosting the out-of-state hams and hope to see more of you next year.

Top QRP Station

Great propagation was had for QRP operation this year! There were 37 (11 in-state, 26 outside WI) QRP entries this year vs. 15 last year. The timing could not have been better for changes to the WIQP QRP award.

In Wisconsin

Rick McGaver, NK9G, was the top QRP station in Wisconsin with 103,292 points on 355 Q's. Dan Alwin, KE0TT, was the runner up with 26,560 points on 118 Q's.

Non-Wisconsin

Jim Lageson, N0UR, took first place for the top QRP station outside Wisconsin with 17,192 points on 117 Q's operating from Minnesota. Ben Cahill, AC2YD, had second honors with 15,020 points on 95 Q's operating from New Jersey.

Top VHF Station

VHF activity was much higher this year. 60 logs had Q's made on 6m or above represented by 5 bands, 6m, 2m, 220, 440, and 900. The Fox Cities Amateur Radio Club was instrumental in bolstering this activity by activating a group of mobiles and fixed stations.

First place was Zachariah Monasmith, KD9TQP with a VHF score of 4,968.5 points from 89 Q's. Randy Plachinski, KD9CLI, came in second with 1,912.5 points on 55 Q's.

Club Competition

Aggregate club scores were very competitive in 2023 and the Fox Cities Amateur Radio Club was awarded first place with an aggregate score of 385,923.5 points with a 26-member contribution. In second place was the West Allis Radio Amateur Club with an aggregate score of 355,050.5 with a 10-member contribution.

W9FK Bonus

The W9FK bonus station was active on phone and CW this year. Special thanks go out to Phil Gural, W9NAW, and Mike Lawrence, N9UA. Both were fixed stations; Mike's CW station was active from Winnebago County and Phil's phone station was active from Waukesha County. A total of 623 Q's were made, 427 on CW and 196 on phone. Thank you, Mike and Phil, for being W9FK for a day. We hope you had as much fun working the pile-ups as we did creating them!

If you haven't been submitting your log, please reconsider. We want your logs!

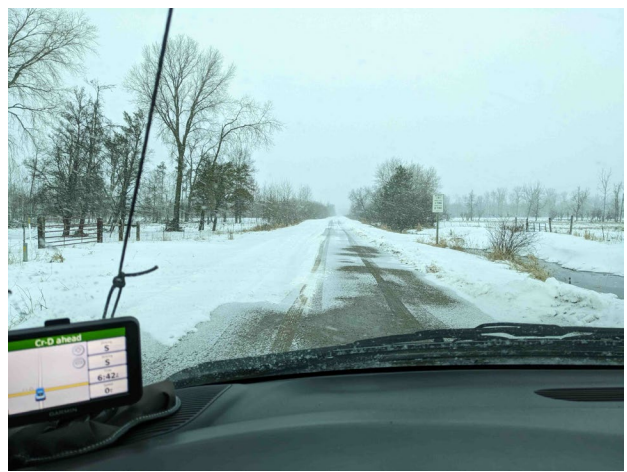

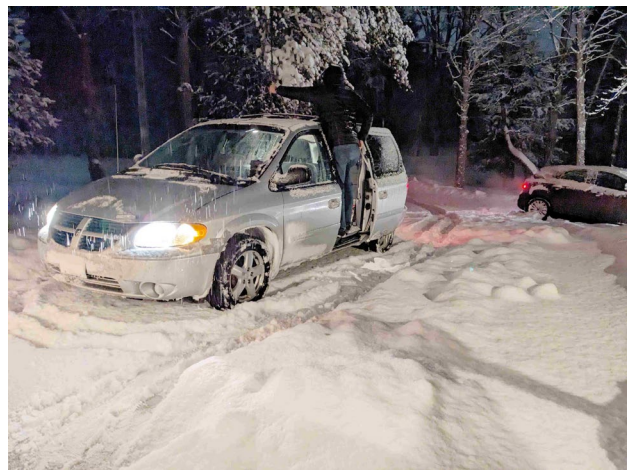

Waking up to 6+ inches of snow what later turned into 9-13 inches in central WI, I was preparing that Todd and I would come to the conclusion of bagging the mobile ops due to bad weather. Luckily the weather let up and we decided to give it a try. Starting out I was still doubtful we'd make it through the 12 county planned route, but we kept pushing and made it all of the way to 8pm without issue. I couldn't have asked for a better first time experience and the added spice of a snow storm to make things a little sketchy. On the radio side of things it was a great to experience with all of the repeat chasers. Thank you to everyone that contacted me. The highest occurrence was N9DJ with 11 contacts followed by N5AU and OM2VL for 10 contacts, and then LA8OM, SP5SA, and LY5W. I wish I could have done better in many areas, but that is motivation for coming back next year with goals. For some reason I wasn't able to produce a pileup on 40M CW with many strong stations on phone and first time calls and RBN reporting respectable signals. From a numbers standpoint lack of 40M contacts was probably the largest gap. This was my all time high scoring record (and only one) mobile WIQP entry! Thank you N9NE for your generosity and encouragement! Thank you WARAC and sponsors for hosting the WIQP. Todd, N9NE here, the driver.... We drove 285 miles in 'interesting' weather and road conditions and were fortunate to have been able to activate all dozen counties very close to the times we had planned.
